He runs a regional renal genetics clinic and a family renal genetics clinic.

Within the Translational and Clinical Research Institute at Newcastle University, Professor Sayer's laboratory studies focus on renal genetics, cystic kidney disease, renal ciliopathies and renal stone formation. His work utilises physiological and genetic techniques to investigate these conditions and find new therapies.
